

Crockpot Chicken Soup!

ingredients

- I ½ Ibs. Boneless skinless chicken breast
- I large onion, chopped
- 3 carrots, peeled and sliced
- 2 stalks celery, sliced
- 4 tsp. Fresh thyme
- 4 tsp. Fresh rosemary
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- Sal
- Black pepper
- 10 cups low-sodium chicken broth
- 8 oz. Egg noodles

instructions

- Chop, slice, and mince your onion, carrots, celery, and garlic as mentioned in the ingredients above.
- 2. In a slow cooker, combine the chicken, onion, carrots, celery, thyme, rosemary, and garlic, and season generously with salt and pepper to your desired taste. Pour in the chicken broth.
- 3. Cover and cook on low for 6 to 8 hours. Then remove the chicken from the slow cooker and shred. Discard any fresh herbs that you originally incorporated into the cooker and return the shredded chicken to the pot. Add in the egg noodles before covering.
- **4.** Continue to cook covered and on low until egg noodles are al dente, about 20 to 30 minutes.
- 5. Serve & enjoy!
